

## Keith Taylor MEP expenses summary

### January - June 2013

#### Staffing costs

The Parliamentary allowance covers Keith's staffing costs. Each MEP can claim up to a maximum monthly allowance of 21,209 euros per month for staffing and associated costs such as pension, training, insurance, tax, and national insurance. Keith's team currently consists of:

All London based staff receive an additional London weighting of £5000 per annum pro rata.

#### Office costs

General allowance is claimed for Keith's offices' running costs. Keith receives 4,299 euros a month. Any money that is not used is returned to the Parliament. Over the last 6 months Keith has spent:

### Travel

Keith claims for his travel between his constituency and the European Parliament in Brussels. He also has to travel to Strasbourg approximately once a month to attend European Parliamentary plenary. The Parliament covers all these journeys. Over the last 6 months Keith has claimed for:
